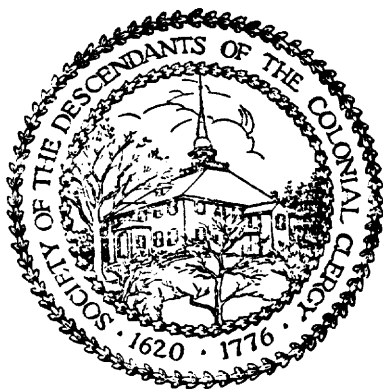

TITUS SMITH, A.B., b. South Hadley, June 4, 1734, son of Dea. John and Elizabeth (Smith) Smith; Y. C., 1764, A.B.; Ord. Apr. 24, 1765, as missionary to the Indians; sett. Onohoguaga; sett. Granby, 1768; sett. Danbury, Ct., 1770-1773; re-ordained at Boston as a Sandemanian Elder; d. Halifax, N. S., Sept. 15, 1807, a. 73.

WILLIAM SMITH, A.M., b. Charlestown, Jan. 29, 1706/7, son of Capt. William and Abigail (Fowle) Smith; H. C., 1725, A.B., A.M.; Ord. Weymouth, (1st Chh.), Dec. 4, 1734; sett. Weymouth, 1734-1783; his dau. Abigail Smith married President John Adams and was the mother of President John Quincy Adams; d. Weymouth, Sept. 17, 1783, a. 77.

JOSEPH SNOW, JR., b. Bridgewater, Mar. 26, 1715, son of Dea. Joseph and Elizabeth (Field) Snow; Ord. Providence, R. I., (Beneficent Cong. Chh.), Feb. 1747; sett. Providence, R. I., 1745-1803; d. Providence, R. I., Apr. 10, 1803, a. 89.

JOHN SOUTHMAYD, A.B., b. Middletown, Ct., Aug. 23, 1676, son of Capt. William Southmayd; H. C., 1697, A.B.; Ord. Waterbury, Ct., May 30, 1705; sett. Waterbury, Ct., 1699-1755; d. Waterbury, Ct., Nov. 14, 1755.

EBENEZER SPARHAWK, A.M., b. Brighton, June 15, 1738, son of Noah and Priscilla (Brown) Sparhawk; H. C., 1756, A.B., A.M.; teacher, 1756-1760; Ord. Templeton, Nov. 18, 1761; sett. Templeton, 1761-1805; d. Templeton, Nov. 25, 1805.

JOHN SPARHAWK, A.M., b. Cambridge, 1672, son of Nathaniel and Patience (Newman) Sparhawk; H. C., 1689, A.B., A.M.; Ord. Bristol, R. I., June 12, 1695; sett. Bristol, R. I., 1693-1718; d. Bristol, R. I., Apr. 29, 1718, a. 45.

JOHN SPARHAWK, A.M., b. Bristol, R. I., Sept. 1713, son of Rev. John Sparhawk; H. C., 1731, A.B., A.M.; Ord. Salem, Dec. 8, 1736; sett. Salem, 1736-1755; d. Salem, Apr. 30, 1755, a. 42.

NATHANIEL SPARHAWK, A.M., b. Cambridge, 1694, son of Dea. Nathaniel and Abigail (Gates) Sparhawk; H. C., 1715, A.B., A.M.; Ord. Lynnfield, Aug. 17, 1720; sett. Lynnfield, 1720-1731; d. Lynnfield, July 1, 1731; d. Lynnfield, May 7, 1732, a. 38.

SAMPSON SPAULDING, A.M., b. Chelmsford, June 7, 1711, son of John and Mary (Barrett) Spaulding; H. C., 1732, A.B., A.M.; Ord. Tewksbury, Nov. 23, 1737; sett. Tewksbury, 1737-1796; d. Tewksbury, Dec. 15, 1796, a. 86.

SAMUEL SPEAR, A.M., b. Braintree, July 6, 1696, son of Samuel and Elizabeth (Daniel) Spear; H. C., 1715, A.B., A.M.; school teacher at Truro; sett. Provincetown, 1717-1741; d. 1748.

DAVID SPRAGUE, b. Hingham, Apr. 12, 1707, son of David
