**K** N O W all Men by these Presents, That we *Samuel Southmayd & David Foot* Both of *Waterbury* in the County of *New Haven*

are Holden, and stand firmly Bound and Obliged unto *Daniel Sherman* Esq; Judge of the Court of Probate for the District of *Waterbury* in the Penal Sum of *five Hundred pounds Lawfull money* of said Colony: To be paid to the said *Daniel Sherman* Judge, or his certain Attorney or Successors, in *his office* well and truly to be made, and done, w<sup>ch</sup> the said *Samuel & David*

do bind ourselves, and each of us, our Heirs; Executors, and Administrators, and each and every of them, for, and in the whole, firmly by these Presents, signed with our Hands, and sealed with our Seals, Dated at *Waterbury* the *6<sup>th</sup>* Day of *October* in the Year of our Lord, 1778

**T**HE Condition of this Obligation is such, that if the above Bounden *Samuel Southmayd* Administrator of all, and singular the Goods, Chattles, Credits, and Estate of *William Southmayd* deceased, do make or cause to be made, a true and perfect Inventory, of all and singular the Goods, Chattles, Credits, and Estate of the said deceased, which have, or shall come to the Hands, Possession, or Knowledge of the said *Administrator* or into the Hands, or Possession of any other Person or Persons, for him; and the same so made, do Exhibit, or cause to be exhibited into the Registry, of the said Court of Probate, in the District of *Waterbury* at, or before the *first* Day of *December* next ensuing: And the same Goods, Chattles, Credits, and Estate, and all other the Goods, Chattles, Credits, and Estate of the said deceased, at the Time of his *Death*, which, at any Time after shall come into the Hands or Possession of the said *Administrator* or into the Hands or Possession of any other Person or Persons for him, do well and truly Administer according to Law. And further, Do make or cause to be made a true and just account of his said Administration, at or before the *first* Day of *February* And all the rest and residue of the said Goods, Chattles, Credits, and Estate which shall be found remaining upon the said *Administrators* Account; the same being first examined and allowed by the said Court of Probate, shall deliver and pay unto such Person or Persons respectively; as the said Court of Probates, by their Decree or Sentence, pursuant to the true Intent and Meaning of the Law, shall limit and appoint and if it shall hereafter appear that any last Will and Testament was made by the said deceased, and the Executor or Executors therein named, do Exhibit the same into the said Court, making Request to have it allowed and approved accordingly; if the said *Administrator*

being thereunto required, do render and deliver the said Letters of Administration, (approbation of such Testament being first had and made) in the said Court, then this Obligation to be Void, and of none Effect; or else to remain in full Force and Virtue
